Aluminum Coils

Earlier this year, Carrier began to manufacture a limited number of residential split system air conditioners and heat pumps with aluminum tube / aluminum fin technology. This is not the technology used by Carrier decades ago, but an improved coil with several technological improvements. Don't worry, the stub-outs for line-set connections remain copper.

To ensure that the new alloy and manufacturing processes result in a product that is superior to what we have today, the transition will be slow and deliberate. Right now, only one model available in Northern California has aluminum tubes: 24ABB324W0L3. However, as we move through 2014, expect more air conditioner and heat pump products to be introduced.

Note the "L" toward the end of the model number. While the AHRI ratings are the same, new certificates must be used the show this correct part number.

Technical Tips

Q: Whoa, this thing has no strip-heat, now what?

Yea, we hear this one all the time. For a host of reasons heat pumps get installed without a supplemental heat source and the first cold snap the phone starts ringing off the hook. When you stumble upon one of these situations here is what you should consider.

First things first – heat pumps have a balance point, economic and thermal. A quick evaluation of the equipment installed and the load of the structure will help determine the required heater size for supplemental heat.

Next is the electrical requirement. Unfortunately, supplemental heat is at times selected based on existing wire and disconnect size. That's not the best selection method, but it's understandable. Do the end user a favor and give it to them straight -- an electrical upgrade may be necessary. Better to be properly equipped than to be cold and wondering why.

The third point is finding the right components to do the job properly. Some supplemental heat packages are no longer available for older units. So you'll have to "part" them out or go find a third party source to obtain an after-market solution. Whatever route you take, ensure the components you install are agency listed.
