Technical Tips

Q: The furnace is blinking Code 33 but it's operating. What's up??

Yep, you can see this situation on multi-stage variable speed furnaces and it is a normal sequence of the board software. In the troubleshooting book, you'll see a description that reads: the furnace is operating in high stage only due to 2 successive limit trips in low heat or at a capacity less than 71% with modulating furnaces.

With multi-stage furnaces, the maximum capacity has the highest airflow and lowest temperature rise. If a condition exists that prevents the furnace from operating at a lower capacity without tripping the limit, instead of providing no heat, the furnace will try to provide maximum.

When you come upon this condition, power cycle the furnace to clear the Code 33, then begin the process of determining the cause of the limit trips at lower capacity. A common cause is the combination of high manifold pressure and low airflow. Verify proper manifold pressure as described in the Installation Instructions, then consider adjusting Low Heat Rise to "ON" via the dipswitch if the furnace is controlled by a 24V thermostat, or via the setup configurations in the Infinity Control. Then, operate the furnace throughout the various capacities and verify the temperature rise is within the values stated on the nameplate. Lastly, don't forget to check the filter!
