Technical Tips

A common cause of intermittent communication errors with the Infinity system is the use of condensate pump interlock or overflow switch. In the old school way, most installers will install the switch so it opens a wire to the outdoor unit. With a 4 wire Infinity system it's usually the red wire, which happens to power the outdoor board. With the newer 2 wire systems, the yellow is generally used, which is the communication wire. Either way, opening the wire when the condensate switch opens results in a loss of communication.

By the time a service technician arrives on site, the condition may have cleared. Everything operates fine through a couple short test runs, and you're off to the next call. Two days later, same situation, call-back, and frustration for both the homeowner and technician.

So how do you fix this? Utilize the "G" interlock option with the Infinity system. Instead of getting a communication error the Infinity system will log a system event in the buffer indicating the G interlock had opened. homeowner and technician will know something is up with the condensate drain system and be able to key in on the issue and get it corrected.
