# Working Safely Inside a Home

The United States Department of Labor's Occupational Safety and Health Administration provides detailed guidelines for in-home repair services at <u>www.osha.gov/SLTC/covid-19</u>. Here is a brief summary of these guidelines so your homeowners can get an idea of what to expect when you visit their home.

- Assess the risk for worker exposure based on community spread of COVID-19, and whether the homeowner has been exposed to or is having symptoms of COVID-19
- Determine the urgency of the job routine maintenance, system repair or complete system replacement
- Determine availability of physical barriers from occupants exposed to COVID-19 using closed doors, walls or plastic sheeting
- Have employer/employee education on local, state and federal guidance regarding COVID-19
- Train employees on social distancing, hand hygiene, respiratory etiquette, and use/disposal of PPE
- Establish in-home practices such as separation from exposed/infected

occupants, request occupants to observe respiratory etiquette, discontinue of service if necessary, and establish good airflow/ventilation

- Establish safe work practices with regards to gloves, disinfectants, sanitizers, distancing, physical contact and any shared items
- Encourage payment by electronic means
- Workers likely will not need additional personal protective equipment (PPE) other than those already routinely used

### **Technical Tips**

#### Q: Can the Infinity System software be updated?

The SYSTXCCITC01-B Infinity user Interface can be updated in two ways. An OTA (Over the Air) software update is done wirelessly through Wi-Fi. This can be done by agreeing to a posted update request on the home screen or manually searching for available updates in the UI software update menu. The software can also be manually updated by inserting a micro SD card into the UI after following the steps in the software update section of the service menu. If necessary, earlier version software can be loaded using the SD card.

When choosing a micro SD memory card, pick one between 4GB and 32

GB. The card will need to be formatted as a FAT32 device. This can be checked using a computer with a micro SD card slot.

The new Carrier Infinity 24VNA6 and 25VNA4 are also equipped to accept software updates through the user interface. These software updates and details for each installation can be downloaded on HVACPartners in the software menu of the equipment documents tab. After downloading the software, the folder title on the card will be "TSTAT" for the UI. The outdoor unit software update will be in a folder titled "EQUIP." You will need both if you have a 24VNA6 or 25VNA4.
