Technical Tips

Q: Why is it taking a long time for the cooling to come on?

The time of the year for cooling and heating during the same day looms near. If their system is in "Auto" mode, be ready for the call from your homeowner.

Most popular thermostats have some type of delay or temperature delta that must be met before the system can change modes. The Infinity UI has an adjustable delay for auto mode heat/cool changeover. The default setting is 30 minutes, with a range of 5 to 120. You may have noticed a Simultaneous Heat/Cool configuration, but that is only available for zoning systems. It does shorten the delay time, but at a cost to efficiency.

If you're working on a Carrier multizone ductless system, the indoor display will show two dashes when one indoor unit is calling for a different mode than other indoor units. Auto mode should not be used, and the default is priority heat. An example of this mode conflict would be a south side upstairs bedroom having to wait for cooling until the main level north nursery is warmed up.

For most shoulder season complaints, instructing the homeowner on how to use auto mode during the installation and routine maintenance calls can go a long way in preventing avoidable callbacks.!
