When you're not using Carrier's Infinity Series equipment, you have several choices for zoning. A great option is ZoneFirst. Technical Tips

Q: What are the right tools for me to do this job well?

As time goes by, you have all become accustomed with the new circuit boards. While they reduce the potential for wiring errors, they can make electrical troubleshooting a challenge if you don't have the proper tools. One very important tool is the Troubleshooting Guide specific to the equipment you are working on, but equally important is the proper voltmeter testing probes.

Most meters come with standard dimension probe tips which may be too large to adequately test an input or output to a plug. Why is this a problem? If you are pushing hard on the connections to touch the contact point, it can weaken the connections.

What do you do if you do not have a fine point in the field? One option is to use individual strands of solid wire, stripped at both ends, then inserted into the plug connection. The wires should then be removed when troubleshooting is complete.

A better option is to purchase fine point meter probe tips. These accessories make troubleshooting easier, are more accurate and prevent damage to the connection. When purchasing probe tips, please make certain the test probes you utilize are rated for the meter, and the voltage being tested. Pro tip – keep fresh batteries in your service vehicle for your meter.
