Rebates, Tax Credits and Eligible Systems

The Inflation Reduction Act passed last year included two major provisions that incentivize residential high efficiency heating and cooling products. Two state administered rebates have the potential to be very lucrative, but the rebates are tied to income and haven't yet been launched. With so many unknowns, it's best to wait for more information, which unfortunately may not be available until Q4 of 2023 or Q1 of 2024.

Fortunately, there is one program available today and that is an extension of the 25C tax credits. You're probably familiar with these credits as they have been available for a while up to \$500. The program has now been updated, effective January 1, 2023. These tax credits are available regardless of income level and are filed with the homeowner's tax return. Rebates from BayRen are still available and this tax credit can be combined with utility programs like that. As is always the case, it's best to advise your homeowner to consult with their tax professional.

In California, the requirements and credits are as follows:

Ducted Split System HP - \$2000

≥15.2 SEER2, ≥11.7 EER2, ≥7.8 HSPF2

Non-Ducted Split System HP - \$2000

≥16.0 SEER2, ≥12.0 EER2, ≥ 9.0 HSPF2

Packaged HP - \$2000

15.2 SEER2, 10.6 EER2, 7.2 HSPF2

Split System AC - \$600

≥16.0 SEER2, ≥12.0 EER2

Packaged AC or Gas/Electric - \$600

≥15.2 SEER2, 11.5 EER2

Gas Furnace - \$600

≥97.0 AFUE

Technical Tips

Q: What causes a limit switch to trip and how do I fix it?

These are fairly common tech support calls that come in two varieties: (1) I am looking at this system and it is constantly tripping on limit. Or, (2) the homeowner tells me that the furnace has to be reset from time to time.

The first place to start is the gas pressure. When was the last time it was checked and adjusted? We often find that the pressure will be set too high and needs to be adjusted. On an older system, you may find that the pressure had never been set and the furnace has been riding the limit for years. In addition to adjusting the pressure, it's recommended that you replace the high limit. Those switches

are not designed to trip and reset continuously.

If the pressures look good, next move to the filter and ensure it is clean. If it's brand new, you may want to check the garbage cans in the backyard to see what the homeowner replaced just before you arrived!

Finally, spend some time looking at the ductwork. Look for collapsed, crimped, or crushed ducts or registers that are closed. Is each run sized correctly? Are there adequate returns? With an older duct system, it may have been sized for heating instead of cooling and may need to be replaced.
