Technical Tips

Summer is finally coming to an end and your homeowner has now turned their mini split from cooling to heating. They call up to tell you that the louver is open halfway and there is no fan. Or, if it's a ducted system, they may tell you that the condenser tried but then stopped without giving any fault codes.

This is an indication that the system is low on refrigerant. Remember that the T1 sensor starts the fan in heating mode when it senses 104 degrees. However, that sensor doesn't control the fan in cooling mode.

Start by switching the system into cooling and add a couple of ounces of

refrigerant to get the system running. Then, turn the system back to heat and look for blower action. If there is no fan, repeat the process again. This will make it easier to locate those small leaks because the lines will be under higher pressures in heating. Inspect those flair fittings. Remember it is your job to locate and repair all known refrigeration leaks.

After you have repaired those leaks remember the refrigeration credo for mini split systems - when in doubt weigh it out! Remove and weigh the gas that was in the system and recharge it to factory specs with new refrigerant.
