## **Technical Tips**

How many times have you rushed through your jobs because your office is pushing you to hurry to your next appointment? Whatever the reason may be, do not feel like you must hurry to finish what you are doing. When we feel rushed -- we take shortcuts, make unnecessary mistakes, and it generally puts you in a bad mood.

Unfortunately, the easiest shortcuts to take are those related to the AC. Maybe we don't flow nitrogen when we are brazing our line sets, or not pulling a deep vacuum on the system, or just adding "a few seconds" of refrigerant to a system because it is low. This gets done more often than you think!

Nobody likes being called back to a new system to diagnose a restricted TXV because a piece of oxidation came off the inside of the line set. Or having to replace a compressor that has acid burn out because you "didn't have time" to pull a deep vacuum. How about that day you added "a few seconds" of refrigerant to the system that now has a bad compressor because the charge wasn't correct.

Take the time that is needed to be thorough and complete the task at hand. All these shortcuts may save you a few minutes today, but over time they are going to catch up with you and cost you more time than you saved.
