The DiversiTech PF-KIT Pro-Flush Solvent Kit makes servicing quick, easy, and safe. When you're not using Carrier's Infinity Series equipment, you have several choices for zoning. A great option is ZoneFirst. While you may not recognize the name, ZoneFirst was the first company that successfully developed and marketed HVAC Zoning Systems back in the 1950's. Their zone board can be used with any non-communicating thermostat and the dampers are easily connected with telephone wire (25-feet included).

When using a zone system with an A2L refrigerant like R454B, it's important to understand how the system will operate if a leak is detected. ZoneFirst's wiring diagram makes it easy without any relays or additional components by simply breaking R to all of the thermostats which causes the dampers to open.

Technical Tips

Q: What should I do with this harness that ships with the 45MU air handler?

When wiring either the 45MUAQ or the 45MUHAQ in the scenario 3 (24VAC) option, you need to be using the CN15 harness connector that comes in the loose parts bag. This CN15 harness connector is required to allow for the dissipation logic to shut off the outdoor unit when a refrigeration leak is sensed. Without this harness in place, the dissipation system is bypassed and not active.

The CN15 harness connector plugs into the AHU 24V board and is wired to the outdoor unit 24V terminals. The wires on this harness are labeled OY2, OY1, OB/O, OW, and COM. Think of the "O" as "Out" or "Outdoor" signal.

If connecting the indoor to outdoor using the S1/S2 communication, this harness is not required. In a dissipation event, communication would control the outdoor unit's operation through the board's logic, but this does not mean you should throw this harness away! Leave the harness at the jobsite, along with the remote control in case they are needed in the future.

If you have not been using this harness connector when required, it's a safety issue for your homeowners and the system is not installed to code. A replacement harness connector is available, part 17401203028966.
