Technical Tips

Q: What's on your Spring Cleaning list?

Spring has arrived and it's that time of year when pre-season maintenance calls are filling up your schedule. This winter was mild, so you may need to note a few items that didn't require as much attention in previous years.

First on the list are plants and shrubs. The mild winter temperatures combined with plentiful sunshine has resulted in atypical growth. Aside from adequate access for you to perform your job, a homeowner may be unaware that one of their plants may become a future outdoor coil blockage. It might be obvious, but take a moment or two to scope out the area and provide the homeowner

guidance on what should hit the top of their Garden Spring Cleaning list.

Second, are bugs and critters. Before starting the outdoor unit, disconnect the power supply, remove the control box cover, and thoroughly inspect circuit boards and contactors for evidence of bugs. Spider webs/nests or earwigs on contact points and armatures can create real problems. Slugs on top of, or beneath a circuit board, can cause shorts. In some cases it may already be too late, so it's always best to have a digital camera. Explaining to a homeowner an earwig is the cause of a failure is easier if you show it to them directly.
